*****Important Pre-Operative and Post-Operative Information****

- You will receive a pre-procedure phone call 1- 3 days before your procedure. The nurse will be asking you about your medical history, medications and allergies. If you have any concerns please tell the nurse at this time.
- Please remove all hairpins, jewelry and body piercings before to your appointment.
- Please complete the attached Health Questionnaire (front and back) you received from your physician's office.
- If you have a Pacemaker or implanted defibrillator, please bring your identification card and the name of your cardiologist.
- For your safety: A family member or friend must accompany you to and from the RGH WILSON CAMPUS GI/Endoscopy unit.
- After discharge you are being advised not to do the following because of the sedation medication you were given during your procedure: You may not work, drive, operate machinery, make major decisions or drink any alcohol for the remainder of the day. A non-medical taxi may be used only if you have someone to accompany you. A bus is NOT acceptable.
- A Registered Nurse will review your discharge information with you and a copy of this information will be given to you to take home. Your physician will speak with you and your family member or friend before you are discharged home.
